## MINORS: Minimum 4 courses / 12 credits

A student may use general elective credits in a minor, but may not use required courses or designated electives to satisfy minor requirement At least 6 credits toward a minor must be completed in-residence

## GRADUATE LEVEL COURSES

Undergraduate students may take a maximum of 12 credits of graduate level course work (minimum 75 credits complete, GPA 3.00 or higher) Consult with your academic advisor about applying these courses to a graduate degree

Please note Thomas Jefferson University residency requirement:
The University has a residency requirement of 60 credits for Day Division students. Students must take a minimum of 60 credits -12 credits must be within the major core; 9 credits must be in Hallmark courses in order to be eligible for a B.S. or B. Arch. degree.
