<u>Some Difficulty</u> = My child is able to do this some of the time, but may need extra time, and it may take a good effort. He/she often needs someone's help.

<u>Little Difficulty</u> = My child is able to do this almost all of the time, but may need extra time and it may take a little effort. He/she doesn't usually need someone's help.

<u>Without Difficulty</u> = My child is able to do this without someone's support or help.
