Re: New 8-hour requirement for DEA license

Dear SKMC Students and Graduates,

As you may have heard, beginning June 27, 2023, all DEA practitioners will be required to check a box on their DEA registration application or renewal form confirming that they have satisfied the new, one-time, training requirement. This requirement is an 8 hour, comprehensive curriculum related to substance use disorders. You are not required to list/document the courses that fulfill this requirement.

All SKMC graduates, since 2018, have successfully completed an 8+ hour comprehensive curriculum that meets this requirement. This requirement includes:

- Treating and managing patients with opioid or other substance use disorders, including the appropriate clinical use of all drugs approved by the Food and Drug Administration for the treatment of a substance use disorder; or
- Safe pharmacological management of pain and screening, brief intervention, and referral for appropriate treatment (SBIRT) of patients with or at risk of developing opioid and other substance use disorders.

**SKMC graduates prior to 2018** must complete at least 8 – hours of CME activities that meet this new requirement (please click on the link above for more information)
