

PROGRESSION THROUGH THE CURRICULUM

- Students entering the program with fewer than 60 credits are required to complete at least nine (9) of the required General Education courses before proceeding on to Foundation courses.
- Students are required to complete all General Education requirements before proceeding on to Major or Major Elective courses.
- Foundation courses serve as prerequisites for Major requirements and, where indicated, must be completed before courses required for the Major.
- The Internship is taken as the final course in the major and is taken immediately following ID 302.
- For graduation, students are required to achieve an overall minimum GPA of 2.0 and a minimum GPA of 3.0 for the eleven (11) to fourteen (14) courses taken for the major.
- If they so wish, students may “pace” their progress through the curriculum by first completing an associate’s degree in business, information systems or medical practice management. All courses required for the associate degrees are directly applicable to, or part of, one or both of the majors of the bachelor of science degree.
