- Continue to stress the importance of professionalism and leadership qualities in students and acknowledge Leadership LIVE as one way to develop these qualities
- Recognize those students participating in Leadership LIVE. One department, Radiologic Sciences, celebrated their students' accomplishments in Leadership LIVE by recognizing them at their year-end Class Night program
- Make it a class requirement or offer extra credit (e.g., the Department of OT required it as part of their pediatric grant)

“Leadership LIVE gave me a lot of good advice on how to have confidence in myself and work with others. Learning about interview skills also helped me in landing my summer internship this year!”

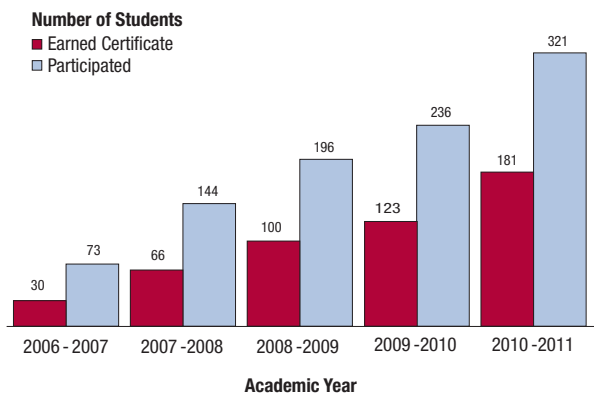

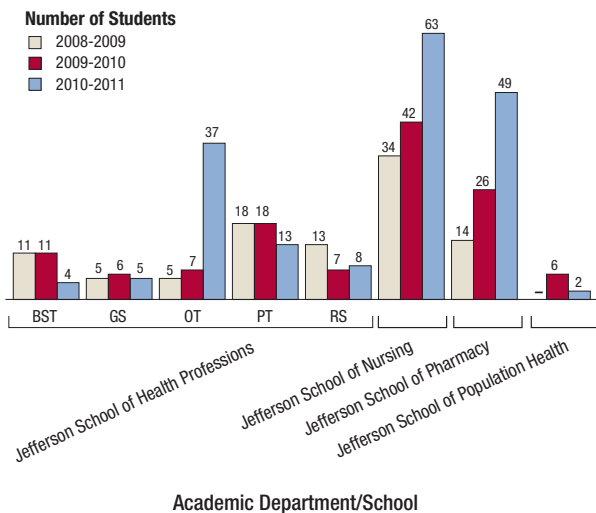
